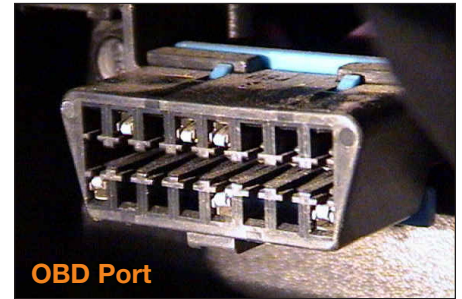


1 Locate OBD port

OBD ports are generally located on the driver's side under the dash. Each make and model has a different location. The website *CarMD* offers a tool to assist in port location for most makes and model. This tool can be accessed at <https://www.carmd.com/wp/locating-the-obd-2-port-or-dlc-locator/>.



2 Plug in device

Plug the device into the OBD port.



3 Secure device with serial number zip tie

Using the serial numbered zip tie, secure the device to the OBD port. Make note of the serial number installed in each vehicle.

When you log into the system the first time, go to Administration > Vehicle Admin and enter the serial number from each zip tie in the *Driver ID* or *Maintenance Notes* field for each vehicle.



4 Log in
